2008 SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS PROGRAM**

- Objectives:** To provide scholarships to qualified students enrolled in an undergraduate program leading to a career in a field related directly to the environment.
- Eligibility:** All undergraduate students currently enrolled or high school students accepted full-time in a four-(4) year college or university program in Western Pennsylvania or West Virginia, **which will lead to a career in the environmental fields.** Applicants should have at least a "B" average or a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applications:** Applications must be received by March 31, 2008. Application materials will be reviewed and awardees selected by the Scholarship Award Committee in May 2008.
- Coversheet (attached)
 - Copy of your most recent college transcript or high school transcript with letter of acceptance from college, and description of your field of study
 - Plan of study
 - Letter of reference and recommendation form (enclosed) from your academic advisor
 - A one-page typed essay indicating your interest in the fields of air, water, or waste management
 - Your resume outlining work history, academic history, awards, hobbies and volunteer work

Please note: Incomplete applications will not be considered.

- Awards:** The Scholarship Award Committee may award up to \$10,000 in scholarships to suitably qualified candidates. Recipients are judged by academic records, plan of study, career goals, recommendations, and extra-curricular activities without consideration of sex, race, national origin, financial need, age or physical disability. Awards will be announced by May 2008.

The Allegheny Mountain Section of the Air & Waste Management Association is a non-profit technical, scientific, and educational organization with more than 300 members in Western Pennsylvania (West of the Susquehanna River).
